To help ensure that the College's faculty, and staff are able to apply for competitive grants, the Grants Office supports the official approval and proposal composition process, including obtaining signatures from administrators who are legally allowed to sign on behalf of Long Beach City College.

## What is the process for starting a grant?

The first step is to contact the Grants Office.

When a grant opportunity is identified and approved by the area's Dean and Vice President, the Grants Office will take the funding opportunity to the President's Cabinet for official final approval.

Once Cabinet's approval is obtained, the Grants Office will work with you to compile and compose the proposal and its associated documents
